Dennis Spragg Glenn Miller Collections

Dennis Spragg coordinates the Glenn Miller Collections at the American Music Research Center, University of Colorado Boulder, serves on the AMRC advisory board and as historian of the Glenn Miller Birthplace Society in Clarinda, Iowa, and is host to GMBS yearly Glenn Miller festival in Clarinda. Meanwhile, with legendary Denver radio personality Rick Crandall, he produces the acclaimed weekly big band broadcast the <u>Star-Spangled Radio Hour</u>. Likewise, Dennis directs the Glenn Miller Collections website and social media. Moreover, he writes widely respected opinion articles that connect the history of America and exceptionalism with current events. Also, influential American and international media have published his articles and essays, as have the Smithsonian and Library of Congress. He appears regularly on radio, television, podcasts and at in-person presentations. Dennis will present Glenn Miller, 1945 Presentation & the Glenn Miller Orchestra Panel scheduled for Saturday at 9:30 am.
